Letter of Understanding

The parties to this letter of understanding are _____

_____ (Property Owners) and the Leesburg Water Association (Association). This letter of understanding is written and signed by the parties so that all will have a full and complete understanding as it relates to the installation of a residential water meter to service land owned by Property Owners. Property Owners understand that only one (1) residential water meter will be installed at the right of way of the public road for use by Property Owners. No additional water meters will be allowed by the Association for the property owned by Property Owners unless all of Association's rules and regulations have been complied with. Specifically, in the event that Property Owners later subdivide their property, no additional water meters will be installed by the Association unless and until the Property Owners are in compliance with the Association's existing subdivision development policy as it relates to water service.

It is the intent of the parties that there will be one (1) and only one (1) water meter servicing the property description attached here to and the only way additional water meters will be authorized for this property will be when Property Owners are in full and complete compliance with any and all Association rules and regulations as determined solely by the Association.
